

Blue Book Level -Home Reading

Phonics book bags must be brought to school daily so that books can be changed.

Words read per minute- time your child reading their book (out loud). Write the score in their reading record every day so their class teacher can see. Tell them they are going to try to beat their score from the day before. We have been doing this in class so they are familiar with this activity. We are aiming for 60-70 words a minute.

Red Words Ask children to practice reading the words across the row, down the column and out and in of order clearly and quickly.
