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If your child is in a sound group they are in the early stages of learning to read. Your child is still learning set 1 sounds. Some children can blend and others are still learning this skill. It does take some children longer than others so please don't worry. Your child will be receiving extra help in school. Once your child can blend sounds together they will bring home a blending book. This contains single words for your child to practise.
